- ▶ English language skills
- ▶ Intercultural knowledge

As a participant, you will also have access to:

- ▶ Professionals working with entrepreneurs
- ▶ A Success Coach for personalized goal setting and support

This pilot program is **free for participants**. To be eligible for this program, you must:

- ▶ Have a business idea
- ▶ Have time in your schedule for ten hours of learning and study per week
- ▶ Have access to a computer with microphone and web-camera during class time
- ▶ Identify as female
- ▶ Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or Convention refugee
- ▶ Have Canadian Language Benchmarks of Level 6 or higher
- ▶ Be willing to share your feedback about the pilot program with Bow Valley College and the Alberta Government
