Transit- Something that carries people from one place to another, usually a bus or train.

App-A useful application that you download onto your cell phone.

Bus routes-The roads, or path, that a specific bus will drive

Fare(s)- the money a passenger on public transportation has to pay.

Prepaid pass- A pass you pay for in advance

Bother- to worry or trouble someone

Disability- a physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses, or activities.

Handicapped- having a condition that makes it harder to function physically, mentally, or socially.

Thrift store- A store that sells used things.

Small talk- Easy conversations with strangers or acquaintances about the weather and other simple topics.

Monthly pass- A pass that allows you to ride the bus for a month without buying individual tickets.

Reduced- make smaller or cost less

Low income- A person, or family, that earns below a certain amount of money, decided by the government, to live comfortably.

Danger- the possibility of being harmed or injured.

Transfer slip- A paper that allows you to change buses or trains within a certain amount of time without paying more money.

LRT- Light Rail Train

Transit Peace Officer- An officer that checks tickets on the LRT train, gives fines, as well as helps in emergency situations.
